EUROPEAN CHALLENGE

Monday 9th July 2018
Bangor University



Our European Challenge is specially aimed at Year 9 and 10 students who are studying **languages** and who are also interested in **international marketing and selling**.

Overview

70% of UK companies are now trading internationally and for most this means marketing and selling their products in other countries. We export more to other European trade partners than to the USA and Commonwealth countries combined, and eight of our top export countries are European, including France, Germany and Spain. We are therefore focusing our challenge on the European countries and targeting the languages of French, German, and Spanish. The main challenge will encompass tasks and activities associated with taking a typical Welsh food product to an international trade fair.

Outline of the day

The day will include:

- A marketing and selling challenge for which there will be a prize for the winning team
- A keynote talk from Alex Pickering of the Goethe Institut
- A presentation by the students using their target language(s)
- An introduction to some marketing techniques
- An opportunity to talk to international business people



During the day, Business Language Champions will be on hand to advise the students and help with language issues.

Who can take part?

You are invited to send a group of 6 **language students** to take part in our European Challenge. We are aiming this at Year 10 or high calibre Year 9 who have opted to take a language GCSE. The group may be of mixed ages. The students must all be learning **French, German or Spanish** and may be a mixture of learners of **different languages**. *They will be allocated to teams working with students from other schools. This event will be run through the medium of English.*



Application details

Registration deadline: Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. As many of our regional events are over-subscribed, we do recommend that you register as soon as possible to avoid disappointment as we have a limited number of spaces.

Applications: Please submit the names of the students, their year group, and the language(s) they are studying. Each group should also send 200 words on what they would like to get out of the day (this can be sent later). Remember to include contact details for your school. Note that we will only reserve places against receipt of names, but you are welcome to advise us of your intention to take part so that we can keep you informed.

Cost: This challenge is £150 per group of 6 and will include lunch and refreshments.

Timing: The day will run from 9.00a.m. (registration) for a 9.20 start to 3.30p.m.

Terms: Please note that once the invoice has been issued, there will be a charge for cancellation of the full £150 unless the place can be filled by another school.
