All the World's Your Stage is specially aimed at Year 12 and Year 13 students who are studying languages. This is a great opportunity to develop your writing and speaking skills, both of which are key at A level.

Overview

During the day, students will be supported to produce a short play in French, German or Spanish, exploring themes that are relevant to their studies. There will be emphasis on both writing and speaking skills so don't worry if a couple of your team members would rather write than act. The day will culminate in a showcase of linguistic talent as teams perform their plays, and there will be a prize for the most outstanding team.

Who can take part?

You are invited to send any number of A Level students from **Years 12 or 13** who are studying **French, German or Spanish**.

Students will be allocated into

teams with a common language. We realise that some schools will have low numbers of students studying languages at A Level and for this reason we are happy to accept individual students who are able to travel independently to the venue without an accompanying teacher. We would ask that a parent accompany the student to the venue though there is no requirement to stay. We hope this will make the event more viable for you.

We would appreciate notification by Friday 30th November but we will continue to accept students after that subject to space.

Applications:

Please submit the names of the students, their Year Group, and the language(s) they are studying. Remember to include contact details for your school. Note that we will only reserve places against receipt of names, but you are welcome to advise us of your intention to take part so that we can keep you informed.

Cost:

This event is £27.50 plus VAT per student and will include lunch and refreshments.

Terms:


Please note that once the invoice has been issued, the full amount will be charged in the event of cancellation unless the place can be filled by another school or student.
